# Key Players Overseeing Environmental Compliance

1

## **NCEC**

National Center for Environmental Compliance oversees environmental permits and compliance for most projects nationwide.

2

## **RCJY**

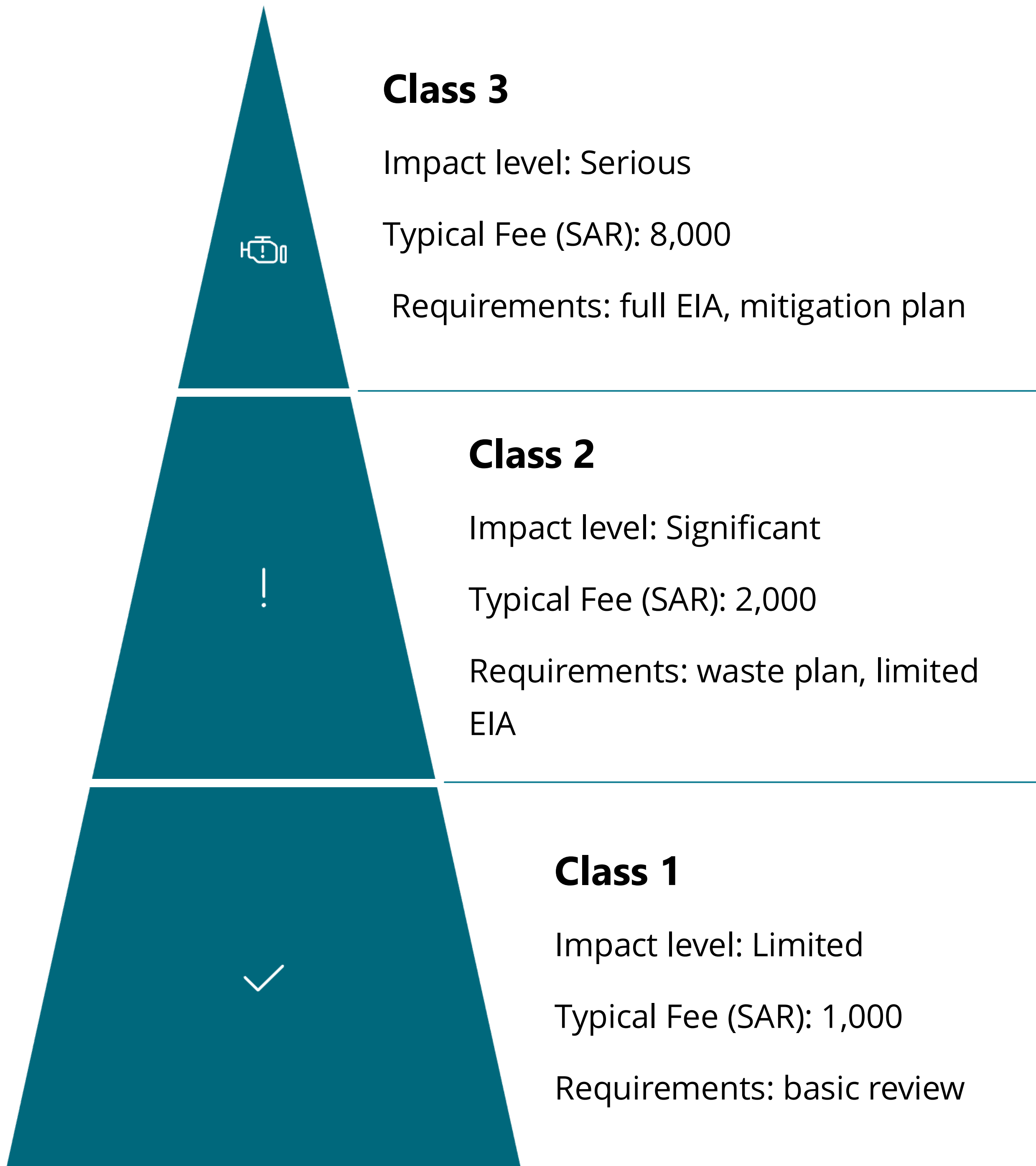
Royal Commission for Jubail and Yanbu Regulates industrial cities (Jubail, Yanbu, Ras Al Khair, and Jizan).

3

## **Specialised Centres**

Wildlife, Meteorology, Vegetation cover required for sector-specific projects.

# Project Classification System





# APPROVAL

## NCEC's FAST Path



### Classify

*Use the NCEC portal for precise project classification.*



### Apply

Submit all documents digitally for rapid review.

### Get APPROVED

*Track status online; approvals now average 30% faster (2025 update).*

**Tip:** *incomplete applications are the top reason for rejection.*

### Efficiency Hack:

Use the NCEC portal for all submissions, processing is 30% faster.

### Checklist Highlights:

- Commercial Registration
- Authorisation Letter
- Waste Management Plan (Class 2/3)
- Environmental Impact Assessment (Class 2/3)

# Step-by-Step Checklist:

1

## Project Classification

- Use the NCEC (or RCJY for industrial cities) online portal to classify your project as Class 1 (limited), Class 2 (significant), or Class 3 (serious impact).

2

## Document Preparation

- Gather required documents:
  - Commercial Registration
  - Authorisation Letter
  - Waste Management Plan (Class 2/3)
  - Environmental Impact Assessment (Class 2/3)
  - Any sector-specific studies (e.g., biodiversity, water use)

3

## Online Application Submission

- Submit all documents digitally via the NCEC or RCJY portal.
- Pay the relevant permit fee (SAR 1,000 / 2,000 / 8,000).

4

## Technical Review & EIA

- NCEC/RCJY reviews your application.
- For Class 2/3: Full EIA review, including public consultation (mandatory for Class 3, recommended for Class 2).

# Step-by-Step Checklist:

5

## Feedback & Revisions

- Respond promptly to any requests for clarification or additional information.
- Revise and resubmit documents if required.

5

## Permit Approval

- Receive your environmental permit digitally.
- Review all permit conditions and compliance requirements.

6

## Implementation & Monitoring

- Begin project activities in compliance with permit conditions.
- Install real-time monitoring systems if required (especially for Class 2/3).
- Submit regular compliance and monitoring reports via the portal.

7

## Renewal & Updates

- Track permit expiry dates.
- Submit renewal applications and updated documentation as needed.

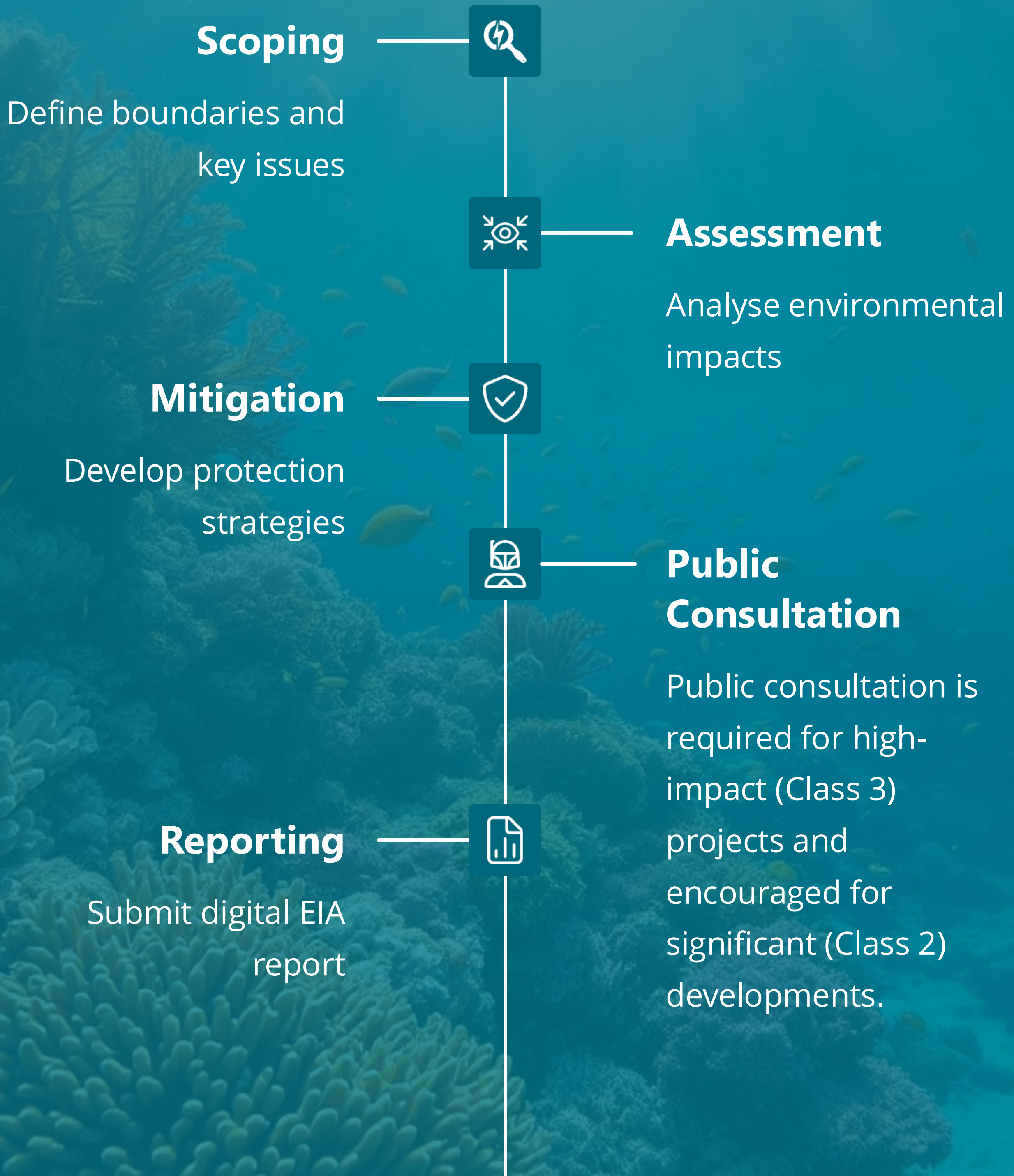

## General Environmental Law Law (2001)

Foundational legislation for environmental protection



## Environment Regulation (Royal Decree M/165, 2021)



## Sector-Specific Regulations

(e.g., RCER-2015 for industrial cities)



## Resource Management Guidelines

Specific protocols for air, water, and waste management



*All aligned with Vision 2030 sustainability targets.*



# Alignment with Saudi Vision 2030



## **Saudi Green Initiative (SGI):**

Net zero by 2060, 10 billion trees, and 30% land/sea protection by 2030



## **Renewable Energy Expansion**

44 GW of projects underway, accelerating clean energy transition



## **Conservation & Biodiversity:**

75 new protected areas established to safeguard habitats and species



## **Sustainable Development**

All permitting frameworks now support Vision 2030's economic, environmental, and digital priorities





# Enforcement and Compliance Measures

## Monitoring

- Regular inspections and environmental audits

## Penalties

- Fines up to SAR 5M (NCEC), SAR 20M (protected areas)
- Repeat violations: doubled fines, license suspension

## Incentives

- SR1B Environmental Fund, recognition for green projects
